(I) General / Minimum Qualifications for the posts Assistant Professor (Contractual) as per UGC Norms & Govt. of Maharashtra Resolution No. Misc-2018/C.R.56/18/UNI-1, dated 08.03.2019.:**A**

- 1) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point - scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned / relevant / allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
- 2) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M. Phil. / Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET / SET :

Provided the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances / Bye-laws/ Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/ Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:

- a. The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in regular mode only.
- b. The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two examiners.
- c. An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted.
- d. The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal; and
- e. The candidate has presented at least two papers, based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/seminars, sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency.

Note :

- 1) The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic affairs) of the University concerned.
- 2) NET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SET is not conducted. However, Ph.D. degree shall remain the minimum eligibility for appointment of Assistant Professor in such disciplines.

The Ph.D. degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following:

- (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS).
- (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or
- (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

(II) Minimum Qualification as per AICTE Notification dated 1st March 2019.

(A) Engineering/Technology :

B.E./B.Tech./B.S. and M.E/M.Tech./M.S. or Integrated M. Tech. in relevant branch with first class or equivalent in any one of the degrees.

(B) Management :

Bachelor's Degree in any discipline and Master's Degree in Business Administration/ PGDM/C.A./ICWA/M.Com. with First Class or equivalent and two years of professional experience after acquiring the degree of Master's degree.

(III) General Terms and conditions as regards qualifications as per UGC Norms & Govt. of Maharashtra Resolution No. Misc-2018/C.R.56/18/UNI-1, dt. 08.03.2019 & Corrigendum dt. 10.05.2019 :

1. A minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed) at the Master's level shall be the essential qualification for direct recruitment of teachers and other equivalent cadres at any level.
2. A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well as at the Master's level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Classes (OBC)(Non-creamy Layer)/Differently-abled ((a) Blindness and low vision; (b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid-attack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness; (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness) for the purpose of eligibility and assessing good academic record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.
3. A relaxation of 5% shall be provided, (from 55% to 50% of the marks) to the Ph.D. Degree holders who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.
4. A relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55%, wherever the grading system is followed by a recognized university, at the Master's level shall also be considered valid.
5. The time taken by candidates to acquire M.Phil. and / or Ph.D. Degree shall not be considered as teaching/research experience to be claimed for appointment to the teaching positions. Regular faculty members up to twenty per cent of the total faculty strength (excluding faculty on medical /maternity leave) shall be allowed by their respective institutions to take study leave for pursuing Ph.D. degree.

(IV) Important points to be borne in mind before filling in Application Form.

1. Candidates should apply online only from 27.08.2024 to 05.09.2024 through the University website admin.unipune.ac.in/recruitment
2. Candidate shall produce original and attested copies of the necessary documents at the time of interview. Candidate should submit the application form along with all enclosures to the Head of the concerned Department at the time of interview for verification.
3. Separate application should be submitted for each post.
4. Qualifications and experience are as notified by the Government of Maharashtra and the University Grants Commission / AICTE and Savitribai Phule Pune University from time to time.
5. **Candidates Should bring the necessary supporting documents with the application in the following order at the time of interview :**
 - (i) Printout of Online Application Form.
 - (ii) Complete Bio-data / CV / Resume
 - (iii) Document in support of Date of Birth.
 - (iv) Copy of Government Gazette or any other appropriate certificate in case of change in name.
 - (v) Caste certificate issued by the competent authority if candidate belongs to Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe / Denotified Tribe / Nomadic Tribe / Other Backward Class / Special Backward Class.

- (vi) Non creamy layer certificate for the candidates belonging to the DT-A, NT-B, NT-C, NT-D, OBC and SBC categories, as per Government of Maharashtra Circular No. CBC 10/2006/Pra.Kra.15/MAVAK 5 dated 5th June 2006, issued by the competent authority valid till the date 31.03.2025.
- (vii) Caste Validity Certificate, if already obtained.
- (viii) Reservation for SEBC is applicable as per Government Resolution No.BCC 2024/Pra.Kra.75/16-C, dated 27.02.2024.
- (ix) As per the Notification No.BBC-2011/Pra.Kra./1064/ 2011/16-B, dated 12th December, 2011, a candidate belonging to the reserved category and appointed against the reserved post, shall submit his/ her Caste Validity certificate within six months from the date of appointment order.
- (x) For the posts reserved for persons with disabilities, Disability Certificate issued by the authorized Medical Expert of the Government Hospitals in the District concerned.
- (xi) Category wise reservation of Posts & procedure of the filling up post of Assistant Professor (Contractual) is as per Govt. Resolution Misc-2019/C.R.-94/19/Vishi-1, dated 11.04.2022.
- (xii) The procedure for filling in the posts reserved for sportsperson shall be as prescribed in the Government of Maharashtra Resolution No. RaKriDho-2002/Prakra68/KriYuSe-2, dt. 01st July, 2016 and Government of Maharashtra Resolution No. Sankirna-1716/PraKra18/KriYuSe-2,dt. 30th June, 2022.
- (xiii) Reservation policy for Orphans shall be as prescribed by the Government of Maharashtra Resolution No. Orphan-2022/Pra.Kra.122/Ka-03, dt.06th April, 2023 will be applicable.
- (xiv) As per policy for Women's reservation prescribed in the Government of Maharashtra Resolution No. Mahiaa 2023/Pra.Kar.123/Karya-2, dt. 04 May, 2023 will be applicable.
- (xv) Policy of Social and Parallel Reservation will be implemented as per Government of Maharashtra Circular No. RaAaDho/4024/Pra.Kra.14/16-A dt. 25th January, 2024.
- (xvi) Candidates from Economically Weaker Section (EWS) category shall submit the certificate as per the provisions prescribed under the Government of Maharashtra Resolution No. RAAADho/ 4019 / Pra.kra.31 / 16-A, dt. 12th February, 2019 & dt. 31st May, 2021.
- (xvii) As per provisions prescribed in the Government of Maharashtra Resolution No. Sankirn-2019/Pra.Kra. 94/19/Vishi-1 dt. 11th April, 2022. The reservation of DT-(A), NT-(B), NT-(C) and NT-(D) categories is separate and is internally transferable under the reservation. If a candidate from one of the said categories is not available, the post reserved for that category can be filled in interchangeably, within the categories of DT-(A), NT-(B), NT-(C) and NT-(D).
- (xviii) In the process of selection of Assistant Professor, the academic score as specified in Appendix II (Table 3A) of the G.R. dt. 8th March, 2019 shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates.
- (xix) Candidates belonging to the reserved categories as recognized in the State of Maharashtra shall only be considered under reserved categories. The candidate belonging to the reserved categories from outside the State of Maharashtra will be treated as Open. Those candidates should be apply for open category only.
- (xx) Relevant experience and educational qualifications will be counted as on the last date prescribed for making online applications.
- (xxi) Copy of NET / SET Certificate/s.
- (xxii) For claiming exemption from the requirement of minimum eligibility condition of NET / SLET / SET for the post of Assistant Professor, a document from the concerned University stating that the candidate has been awarded a Ph.D. degree, in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedures for award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009.
- (xxiii) Documents related to educational qualifications, such as Degree / Diploma Certificates, Statements of Marks of the relevant examinations (both side photocopies of the statement of marks), any other certificate relating to the educational qualifications.
- (xxiv) Candidate who has obtained degrees as per Credit System need to provide Certificate of Equivalence in percentage of marks obtained, issued by the Competent Authority.
- (xxv) Any one of the following documents in order to clarify Specialization:
 - (a) Statement of marks of all examinations of post – graduate course mentioning all subjects and indicating the subject of Specialization at the Post Graduate Level.
 - OR
 - (b) Copy of Dissertation in the field of the specialization concerned, submitted by the candidate.
 - OR
 - (c) Copies of Research publications in the field of the specialization concerned, published by the candidate.
 - OR
 - (d) Copy of cover page, Index pages and relevant extract/s of book/s published by the candidate in the field of the specialization concerned.
 - (e) The subject specialization mentioned in this Notification for each post is indicative and desirable. However, candidates possessing the minimum qualifications as per the norms of the UGC for the post of Assistant Professor as the case may be, other than that specified in this Notification of this University, may also apply.
- (xxvi) Appointment Order/s in case of teachers appointed in University/ Government Colleges and Institutions.
- (xxvii) Certificate/s of teaching experience and / or postdoctoral research.
- (xxviii) Application fee of Rs.1,000/- (for Open Category) and Rs.500/- (for candidates belonging to reserved categories), should be paid by online mode. Candidate shall produce the online payment receipt at the time of interview.
- (xxix) Candidates who are fulfill the conditions mentioned in this notification and those who are found eligible after document verification will be eligible for interview.
- (xxx) No correspondence with ineligible candidates will be made by the University.
- (xxxi) Candidates called for interview will have to remain present at their own expenses.
